***What is the purpose of this scholarship?***

To provide financial assistance to individuals for short term educational and leadership related opportunities outside of the college classroom.

***Applications must be approved for eligibility by the Scholarship Committee.***

***Amount of scholarship:*** Two scholarships will be awarded. Each up to and including \$100.

***Who is eligible to apply?*** Any current Chi Epsilon Sigma Member.

***When should you apply?*** Applications are now being accepted through March 15, 2010. Only one submission per member will be considered.

***Application Deadline:*** Must be in-hand of Committee by March 15, 2010.

***Upon what will the scholarship be based?*** The scholarship will be based on a 300 word essay (**at least 300 words, but no longer than 350 words**) to be written by the applicant stating the reasons why they would be a worthy recipient of this scholarship, and how attending this training has or will enhance their employment or leadership abilities in their community. Financial need will be considered.

***What about counties that have professional improvement in their budgets; would this be in addition to those funds?*** Yes

***Do they have to exhaust those funds before applying for these?*** No. This scholarship is available to members above and beyond those funds. ☺

***Can applicants apply for costs associated with the class such as mileage, workbooks, & lodging, as well as the actual cost of the class?*** Applicants may apply for the cost of the class, books or workbooks for the class, mileage, and lodging.

***Proof of enrollment and payment receipts are required and must be included with your application. If you do not attend the training, a full refund to Chi Epsilon Sigma is required.***

***Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by an independent committee, thus allowing board members and committee members to be eligible to receive the scholarships.***
